## Safe Environment

Anyone entrusted with the care, responsibility, and/or supervision of children and youth MUST successfully complete a Level 2 FBI/FDLE background check performed by the Diocese of St. Petersburg based on electronic fingerprinting. In addition, one must complete a three-hour Safe Environment Program (SEP) training course. (If you would like to volunteer at school, chaperone field trips, etc.)
