## St. Joseph Catholic School Rules and Conduct Varsity and JV Athletics

- 1. There will be a yearly \$100.00 charge to participate in the extracurricular sports program. Please pay at the office. Payment must be paid before a player is permitted to participate in games.
- 2. All players will complete a yearly sports physical prior to first practice. Players will not be permitted to practice until the physical is complete.
- 3. All players and parents will complete a Statement of Compliance, Athletic Events Consent and Release, and Rules and Conduct to be turned the office. Players will not be permitted to play in a game until the form is completed and turned in.
- 4. All players will maintain a C average or above in schoolwork. In addition all daily assignments must be completed and turned in. If a student falls below the C average they will be put on probation for a two week period where they will be given the opportunity to bring their average to a C or better. During the probation the student will be allowed to practice and play. If at the end of the probation their average is not a C or better they will not be permitted to play on the team for the remainder of that sports season.
- 5. All players will earn a 15 or below on the school wide behavior program. If a player does not meet the required behavior standard they will be not be permitted to play in the following game.
- 6. If a player has an unexcused absence from practice they will not be allowed to play in the following game.
